The EPA and Kansas state requirements mandate that all persons who work on pre-1978 houses, schools and daycares receive accredited LSWP/RRP training before the work begins. This is required for any construction-related project that disturbs lead-based paint. The EPA and State monetary and imprisonment penalties for non-compliance are extensive! All persons are required to be licensed/certified by the EPA or the appropriate State agency where the work is occurring.

Please note beginning in 2017, City of Hutchinson will be requiring all Contractors registered with City of Hutchinson will have to have three (3) Continuing Education Code Credits. If you took class in January 2016 those hours will count for 2017 but not 2018.

The City of Hutchinson will recognize the RRP/Lead Safety Class to be able to be used for the required Code hours

Also it is a great opportunity to further education and understanding of code requirements
